	Problem	Recommended Action
Trees	South West sector of the Green – low branches on willow which may fall and inhibit mowing.	To be removed
	Loose branch in NE sector	To be removed with tractor
Walls / fences / hedges	OK	No action required
Manhole covers	North East sector of the Green – 2 inadequate manholes, one damaged and one loose	Approach possible owners to make them aware of the need for repair
Drain outlets	Ownership of many drains is unknown. We need to know who owns those which develop leaks	Mapping of ownership of drains, their course and outlet required. Consult drainage survey company
Effluent leaks	Serious leak by Blossom House	Needs professional excavation to discover the source of the problem and to identify whose responsibility it is to repair
Dog Poo	Nothing noticed	No action required
Notices	Nothing needed	
Other Stuff	Some flood debris noticed on The Green	May require moving before mowing
	Damage to the verges by waggons being driven badly
