	<b>Problem</b>	<b>Recommended Action</b>
Trees	Low branches of willow in south west sector of the Green Loose branch in North East sector	Remove – check with SDC for conservation area requirements. May need professional attention Profession help needed
Walls / fences / hedges	OK	No action required
Manhole covers	Blocked manhole and one damaged cover in North West sector	Write to possible owner to ask them to investigate
Drain outlets	Many drain outlets into the beck are hidden or possibly blocked	Discuss with Environmental Health to determine source.
Effluent leaks	Numerous soft spots but no bad smells	Discuss appropriate measures with Environmental Health & with the Village Green Committee
Dog Poo	Recurring problem on Stewart Lane	Investigating siting a further dog waste bin on Stewart Lane.
Notices	OK	No action required
Other Stuff	Damage to verges on south west sector  Potential problem of unlawful parking when visiting future play area	Owner of the vehicle that got stuck has been approached. May require a solicitors letter  Investigate suitable signage near the bridge and at Swallow House turning area.
