You are invited to tender for the following operation:

Cutting the grass within the boundary of the playground, including strimming around the playground equipment

The quoting contractor should provide two prices, from which the Parish Council will select the most suitable arrangement and confirm a contract.

- 1. A total price for a regular cut to take place every 6 weeks, from June to October, totalling 4 cuts
- 2. A single price for a cut, to be used on a call-off contract basis when required

The total area to be cut is 0.18 hectares.

One figure will be accepted from contractors who will be expected to carry out all operations at their own risk.

The successful contractor must confirm:

- that appropriate public liability insurance cover is held by the contractor covering those who will undertake the work
- that a risk assessment will be undertaken before commencing the work, with a report provided to the Parish Council of any risks identified
- that work undertaken will be done in such a way as to mitigate damage to playground equipment

The successful contractor will be expected to complete the work as per the timeframe set out above, subject to weather conditions. Where adverse weather conditions mean the work cannot be undertaken within the set time period above, work should be completed at the next possible opportunity. Payment will not be made if work cannot be undertaken due to adverse weather conditions.

Known hazards in the playground area will be pointed out to the successful applicant but the contractor will be responsible for undertaking their own investigation to discover any possible hazards during their risk assessment.
